The meeting was called to order by ETI-SG Chair Yingjun Angela Zhang at 17:30 local time.

- (1) The meeting started with **introduction by the participants**.
- (2) The Chair introduced the **officers**, including Chair, Vice Chairs, Secretary, Member Relations Chair and Advisory Board (Slides 5).
- (3) The Chair introduced the membership development, the **process to become a member** of the ETI and the current regional membership composition (Slides 6/7).
- (4) The Chair introduced **eight special interest groups (SIG)** that were formed after the ETI-SG meeting in Dresden (Slide 8-10).

- (5) The Chair highlighted the **ETI-SG position paper**, which was produced by the officers in collaboration with the advisory board and the SIG chairs (Slides 11-13). Special thanks go to vice chair Hans-Peter Schwefel, who edited the position paper.
- (6) The Chair referred to the **policy and procedures** documents, which has been agreed upon during the last meeting of the ETI in Kanas (Slide 14).
- (7) The Chair introduced the **Biannual Report**, which has been submitted in Sept. 2018 to the ComSoc Emerging technologies Committee for the biannual ETI review (Slide 15). The ETI SG has applied to be elevated to TC. A decision is expected to be taken at the next TEAC meeting at Globecom 2018.
- (8) The chair reported on **nominations** for symposia chair positions at upcoming conferences and other positions and awards within IEEE (Slides 16-19). Calls for Nominations are announced regularly via the ETI-SGC mailing list. The chair explained that the ETI-SG officers provide recommendations to selection committees based on nominations from ETI-SG members as well as –in many cases- also self-nominations. In many cases, the nominated persons do not necessarily be already a member of the ETI-SG. The detailed boundary conditions and qualification profile is usually communicated with the specific call for nominations.
- (9) The chair reported together with the symposia chairs present at the meeting on the detailed **outcome of recent conference** tracks (ICC, Globecom) as well as workshops organized by the members of the ETI. A detailed report on the tracks, tutorials and workshop at SmartGridComm 2018 was also provided (Slides 21-32). The organizing team of SmartGridComm 2018 was congratulated and thanked for the excellent event.
- (10) The chair finally reported on a number of **special issues of journals** organized by ETI-SG members (Slides 33-41).
- (11) Upcoming meetings (Slide 42):
 - a. The **next meeting** is scheduled for **ICC 2019 in Shanghai/China: 20-24 May, 2019**, Pudong Shangri-La, East Shanghai Hotel
 - b. The **second meeting in 2019** will take place at the **10th SmartGridComm 2019 in Beijing/China: 22-25 October 2019**
