The meeting was called to order by TC-SGC Chair Andrea Tonello at 18:05 CET. During the meeting, the chair presented a **set of slides**, which is part of the meeting minutes.

(1) The chair introduced the **agenda**, which was agreed upon. Also, the minutes of the last meeting were agreed upon. The **membership has increased** by 13 % since Dec 2019 (see slide 6). All participants of the meeting are encouraged to enroll to the mailing list to become a member.

- (4) The **TC awards** will be selected by a committee which needs to comprise at least four members (as a consequence of the discussions regarding the updated P&Ps, see below).
- (5) The **P&Ps** have been updated by Marco Levorato to reflect on-going progress on ComSoc resp. IEEE level. After some discussion of pros and cons, the meeting supported the following motions:
  - a. The **number of members for the awards selection committee** was set to four.
  - b. The **approval of the updated P&Ps** will be made by the voting members in the upcoming weeks.
- (6) A **policy for the use of the TC mailing list** was proposed by the chair and agreed upon by the meeting (see slide 20). With regards to the promotion of open positions, it was decided by the meeting to limit the announcement of senior positions.

- b. The chair announced to work on ideas to foster more technical discussion inside TC. These considerations also include ideas on how to see more activities of some of the SIGs.
- c. There was a short discussion if the research topics discussed in the TC are sufficiently appreciated by IEEE Transactions on Smart Grid. This discussion shall be continued.
